



Eligibility for International Student Applicants

1) Degree Eligibility

- Master's Program
 - Applicants having obtained (or who are expected to obtain) a Bachelor's degree or its equivalent in Korea or an overseas country
- Doctoral Program
 - Applicants having obtained (or who are expected to obtain) a Master's degree in related fields or its equivalent in Korea or an overseas country
- Integrated Master's and Doctoral Program
 - Applicants having obtained (or who are expected to obtain) a Bachelor's degree or its equivalent in Korea or an overseas country
 - Applicants who show academic excellence in their related fields
 - Work experience and language proficiency test score in related fields are desirable

Applicants expected to obtain the required degree for each program must submit their final graduation, certificated by a consular or Apostille, before the semester begins. For fall admission, this deadline is prior to September 1st, and for spring admission, prior to March 1st. Otherwise, the admission decision will be revoked.

2) Citizenship Eligibility

- To apply as an international student (Considered to be non-quota), you must meet either of the following requirements:
 - Be an applicant and have parents with non-Korean citizenship-both the applicants and their parents should be non-Korean citizens
 - Be an applicant who has completed more than 16 years of education outside Korea

Documents Required

☑ [Common requirements - Important]

- All documents should be in English or in Korean. If the original documents are not in English or in Korean, the notarized translations must be submitted.
- All certificates and transcripts must be submitted with Apostille Certificates or Embassy Certificates.
- If your degree certificate or transcript cannot be re-issued by your university, please have the copy of
 the certificate(or transcript) authenticated by the university and submit them instead of the originals.
 (Note: If you submit a duplicate, the original document must be shown to us after admission.)
- Certificate of GPA (Optional) converted into 100 scale or percentage
 - Please submit one of the following documents:
 - 1) An official document issued by the applicant's alma mater describing a grade point average (GPA) converted into 100 scale or percentage (English or Korean)
 - US WES ICAP (Course-by-Course Evaluation) Certificate WES basic or IGPA calculator is not acceptable
 - 3) If the full GPA has been caculated from Scholaro.com or wes.org etc., it is only valid once this document is attested by the graduated university (with the school official stamp on). Apostille or notarization is not necessary.
 - If the transcript does not state your full marks and this document is not submitted, you will be exempt from receiving admission scholarships

Eligibility for KOTRA-HUFS International Trade Strategy Program

1) Degree Eligibility: Master's Program

- Applicants having obtained (or who are expected to obtain) a Bachelor's degree or its equivalent in Korea or an overseas country

2) Citizenship Eligibility

- To apply as an international student(Considered to be non-quota), you must meet either of the following requirements:
 - Be an applicant with non-Korean citizenship—both the applicants and their parents should be non-Korean citizens
 - Be an applicant who has completed more than 16 years of education outside Korea

3) Preferred Qualification

- Work experience, including internships in the field of overseas marketing, international trade, logistics, or the relevant area at either private companies or public organizations are a plus.
 - * Applicants expected to obtain the required degree for each program must submit their final graduation, certificated by a consular or Apostille, before the semester begins. For fall admission, the deadline is prior to September 1st, and for spring admission, prior to March 1st. Otherwise, the admission decision will be revoked.

Selection Process

✓ Document Review & Interview

- The Interview will be conducted in either Korean or English
 - * International students are strongly recommended to possess a TOPIK level 5 certificate or above, or an equivalent level of proficiency in Korean.

Documents Required

☑ [Common requirements – Important]

- All documents should be in English or in Korean. If the original documents are not in English
 or Korean, notarized translations must be submitted.
- All certificates and transcripts must be submitted with Apostille Certificates or Embassy Certificates.
- If your degree certificate or transcript cannot be re-issued by your university, please have the copy of the certificate(or transcript) authenticated by the university and submit them instead of the originals. (Note: If you submit a duplicate, the original document must be shown to us after admission.)
- Certificate of GPA (Optional) converted into 100 scale or percentage
 - Please submit one of the following documents:
 - 1) An official document issued by the applicant's alma mater describing a grade point average (GPA) converted into 100 scale or percentage (English or Korean)
 - 2) US WES ICAP (Course-by-Course Evaluation) Certificate WES basic or IGPA calculator is not acceptable
 - 3) If the full GPA has been caculated from Scholaro.com or wes.org etc., it is only valid once this document is attested by the graduated university (with school official stamp on). Apostille or notarization is not necessary.
 - * If the transcript does not state your full marks and this document is not submitted, you will be exempt from receiving admission scholarships

A. Documents required for applicants and whose parents are all foreign nationals

- 1 A Certificate of nationality of the applicant and their parents, respectively
 - * Chinese applicants: A household register for applicants of Chinese nationality
 - * For applicants from Pakistan, a printed document of valid Nadra Family Registration Certificate (FRC) can be submitted instead of ② Family Relation Certificate ③ Both Parents' Personal ID Cards, but the copy of applicant's passport must be accompanied with this document
- ② Original Family Certificate verifying family relation with the applicant or Birth Certificate that both parents' names are stated
 - Verifying paternity and parents' marriage status
 - * If the family relation certificate doesn't verify relationship between applicants and both parents because of their divorce or death, a traditional certificate of divorce or death must be submitted with notarized translation in Korean or English
- 3 A duplicate copy of passport of the applicant and their parents, respectively
 - * If either of their parents don't have a passport, the copies of both parents' ID cards—except the driving license—that can prove nationality instead are acceptable
 - ⇒ Al documents are only valid within 6 months, and notarized document should be issued after March 1st 2024.

B. Documents required for applicants who have completed 16 years of education outside Korea

- (1) All the graduation certificates and transcripts earned for 16 years from outside Korea
 - All certificates and transcripts must be submitted with Apostille Certificates or Embassy Certificates.
- ② A certificate of entry/departure record for Korea of the applicant
- (3) A duplicate copy of passport of the applicant
